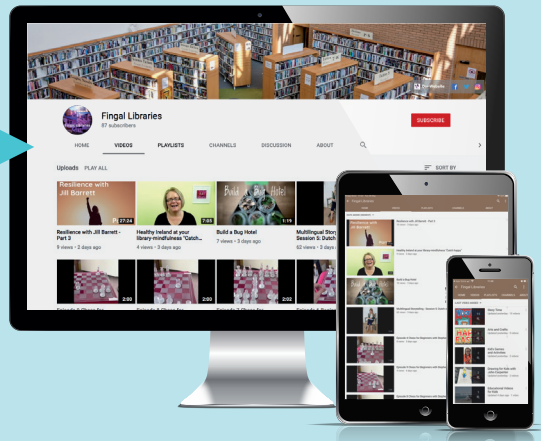
Fingal Library Services
