ROADS ACT 1993 TO 2015 - SECTION 75 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF KILHEDGE LANE. LUSK. CO. DUBLIN

Fingal County Council has made an order temporarily closing Kilhedge Lane, Lusk, Co Dublin to facilitate laying of new foul & storm lines to service the new development of Kilhedge Drive and Court. It is proposed that the road will be closed 24 hours from 3rd May 2021 until 5th November 2021.

While the works are ongoing from 3rd May 2021 to 5th November 2021, vehicles and pedestrians will have no access to Kilhedge lane between the junctions of Dun Emer Avenue with Kilhedge Lane and Chapel Farm Drive with Kilhedge Lane.

Eight submissions were made during the consultation process.

Alternative routes available for vehicular traffic are as follows:

- Motorists approaching Kilhedge Lane from the Old Belfast Road (R132) will be diverted upon reaching the road works via Chapel Farm Drive/Chapel Farm Mews/Chapel Farm Road back onto Kilhedge Lane.
- Motorists approaching from the junction of Dun Emer Avenue with Kilhedge Lane will be diverted via Chapel Farm Road/ Chapel Farm Mews/Chapel Farm Drive back onto Kilhedge Lane.

Local access to all properties will be maintained at all times.
